I. Objective

The firefighter, given a salvage cover that is fully opened on a flat surface, shall demonstrate the proper method for rolling a salvage cover using the “One-firefighter Roll” method. Upon completion, the firefighter will demonstrate a “One firefighter Spread” utilizing the rolled salvage cover. The firefighter shall accomplish the skill in 8 minutes or less.

II. Instructions – Procedures for Achieving the Objective

Given a salvage cover that is fully opened on a flat surface, you shall demonstrate the proper method for rolling a salvage cover using the “One-firefighter Roll” method. Upon completion, you will demonstrate a “One-firefighter Spread” utilizing the rolled salvage cover. During this evaluation, you will give all verbal commands for completion of the steps. You have 8 minutes to complete this skill. You will begin on my instruction to start. The skill will end when you state to me that you have completed the identified steps. Do you understand these instructions?

III. Examiner’s Note

The firefighter will not be allowed to review the performance steps at the time of testing.

IV. Preparation & Equipment

- A. Salvage cover
- B. Furniture or similar items

Note: The firefighter shall accomplish the skills wearing “FULL PROTECTIVE CLOTHING FOR STRUCTURAL FIREFIGHTER” as required by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection to include helmet, gloves, coat, trousers, boots, and SCBA. Firefighter will not don face piece or hood.

Roll for one-fire fighter spread:

- a) Grasps the cover with the outside hand midway between the center and the edge to be folded, places the other a hand as a pivot point midway between the outside hand and the center, and brings the fold over to the center 1.0 _____
- b) Brings the outside edge over to the center and places it on top of and in line with the previously placed first fold 1.0 _____
- c) Folds other half of the cover in the same manner as steps a and b 1.0 _____
- d) Folds over about 12 inches at each end..... 1.0 _____
- e) Rolls and compresses one end to complete a tight compact roll 1.0 _____

One fire-fighter spread:

- a) Starts at one end of the object and unrolls a sufficient amount to cover the end 1.0 _____
- b) Lays the roll on the object and continues to unroll toward the opposite end 1.0 _____
- c) Covers the opposite end adequately 1.0 _____
- d) Stands at one end, grasps the open edges, and opens the sides by snapping hands up and out 1.0 _____
- e) Opens the other end of the cover over the object in the same manner and straightens the cover and tucks in the edges..... 1.0 _____
- f) Completes skill in allotted time..... 1.0 _____
